YouthCARE Busselton to host an 'Evening with Lindy Chamberlain-Creighton' fundraising dinner.

YouthCARE Area Chaplain Karen Nelson is bringing the powerful story of Lindy Chamberlain-Creighton to Busselton this June to raise funds for the local school chaplaincy program.

Ms Chamberlain-Creighton, the woman who was jailed over the disappearance of her baby near Ulluru during a 1980 camping trip and later exonerated, will be the special guest at the YouthCARE fundraising dinner on Saturday, June 6.

She will share her story of hope and forgiveness to an anticipated audience of 250 at the Bayview Geographe Resort in Busselton.

Karen Nelson, the YouthCARE Area Chaplain for the mid south-west, said she approached Ms Chamberlain-Creighton to speak at the fundraising dinner because she was a part of Australian history with an encouraging story of forgiveness.

"I've followed her journey for years and as someone who has worked in both school and community sectors i have seen a lot of hurt out there and I believe we need to hear and learn more about the power of forgiveness to move forward," she said.

"Lindy is the perfect example of demonstrating how forgiveness can lead to freedom."

The Evening with Lindy Chamberlain-Creighton includes a two-course dinner and a message from Lindy Chamberlain-Creighton.

Funds raised from the dinner will go towards supporting the work of chaplains in public schools accross the Busselton region.

YouthCARE chaplains currently work in eight schools (6 primary and 2 high schools) accross the Busselton region. Their role is to support young people and create positive school communities where students are empowered and encouraged to be the best they can be.
